Questions for Nonjudicial Candidates

- 1. Do you support the reversal of the U.S. Supreme Court *Roe v. Wade* decision, which allows abortion for any reason, even as a method of birth control, even in the late stages of pregnancy?
- 2. Do you support a law banning partial-birth abortions, except to prevent the death of the mother?
- 3. Do you oppose the use of public funds for abortions and abortion referrals, except to prevent the death of the mother?
- 4. Do you support a law requiring abortion facilities to give women information about the risks of abortion to themselves, the development of the unborn child, and alternatives to abortion at least 24 hours before she consents to an abortion?
- 5. Do you support a law creating criminal and civil penalties for a third party who kills an unborn child in the womb against the wishes of the mother, such as in cases of assault, drunk driving, or negligence?
- 6. Do you oppose laws allowing assisted suicide?
- 7. Do you support honoring the wishes of patients who want life-saving treatment (including food and water) regardless of their degree of disability, age, and "quality of life"?
- 8. Do you oppose laws that would limit the free speech rights of civic groups to report on public policy issues prior to an election?
- 9. Do you support a ban on all human cloning, including the cloning of human embryos?
