to a sample of 800 that was representative of the general population of Texas
based on gender, race, age, education, party identification, political interest,
and nativity. Weights for Latinos and Non-Latinos were then raked separately, and
rebalanced
based on marginals from the 2006 American Community Survey. Those marginals are
shown below.
